REGULATION NO. 2005/30

**ON THE PROMULGATION OF THE LAW
ON KOSOVO CHAMBER OF COMMERCE
ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF KOSOVO**

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Security Council resolution (UNSCR) 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999,

In conformity with Chapter 8 and sections 9.1.44 and 9.1.45 of the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9 of 15 May 2001),

Taking into account a communication from the President of the Assembly of Kosovo, dated 27 May 2005 concerning the Law on Kosovo Chamber of Commerce adopted by the Assembly on 20 May 2005,

Noting that the provisions of the Law shall be without prejudice to the authority of the Special Representative of the Secretary-General under UNSCR 1244 (1999) or his reserved powers and responsibilities under the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo,

Hereby promulgates, effective as of the date of signature, the Law on Kosovo Chamber of Commerce adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo (Law No. 2004/7) attached to the present Regulation, provided that:

(a) The term "Honour Court" wherever it appears in the text of the Law shall be replaced by "Honour Council";

(b) In article 17 (g), the term "judges" shall be replaced by "members";

(c) Article 25.3 shall be revised to read "The Honour Council decides on administrative non-monetary penalties, disciplinary measures, determines responsibility and issues records of decisions thereon in accordance with the Charter"; and

(d) The terms “National”, “country” and “Kosova” wherever they appear in the text of the Law shall be replaced by “Kosovo”.

These changes shall be reflected in the final official text of the Law.
