



REGULATION NO. 2005/36

**ON THE PROMUGATION OF
THE LAW ON TECHNICAL DEMANDS FOR
PRODUCTS AND VALUATION OF CONFORMATION
ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF KOSOVO**

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the Authority given to him under United Nations Security Council resolution 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999,

In conformity with Chapter 8 and sections 9.1.44 and 9.1.45 of the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9 of 15 May 2001),

Taking into account a communication from the President of the Assembly of Kosovo, dated 29 June 2005, concerning the Law on Technical Demands for Products and Valuation of Conformation adopted by the Assembly on 24 June 2005,

Noting that the provisions of the Law shall be without prejudice to the authority of the Special Representative of the Secretary-General under United Nations Security Council resolution 1244 (1999) or his reserved powers and responsibilities under the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo,

Hereby promulgates, effective as of the date of signature, the Law on Technical Demands for Products and Valuation of Conformation adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo (Law No. 02/L-20) attached to the present Regulation, provided that:

(a) Chapter 5 and Article 15 shall be implemented in conformity with sections 8.1 (m) through (p) of the Constitutional Framework;

(b) In Article 15, the wording “defines by law the way of informing other states (countries) essentially international entity,” shall be replaced by

“may in close coordination with UNMIK develop the ways of informing authorities outside Kosovo of”;

(c) The title of Chapter 7 “Punitive Provision” shall be revised to read “Administrative Sanction”.

The changes in (b) and (c) above shall be reflected in the final official text of the Law
