**REGULATION NO. 2005/39**

**AMENDING UNMIK REGULATION 1999/3  
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CUSTOMS  
AND OTHER RELATED SERVICES IN KOSOVO**

The Special Representative of the Secretary General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under the United Nations Security Council resolution 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999,

Taking into account United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo (UNMIK) Regulation No. 1999/1 of 25 July 1999, as amended, on the Authority of the Interim Administration in Kosovo,

In conformity with sections 8.1(c) and (f) of the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9 of 15 May 2001), and having consulted with the Economic and Fiscal Council,

Having promulgated UNMIK Regulation No. 1999/3 of 21 August 1999, as amended, on the Establishment of the Customs and other Related Services in Kosovo,

Cognizant of the principles contained in the Florence Agreement, sponsored by UNESCO, on the importation of educational, scientific and cultural materials which provide that signatories do not apply customs duties to printed books, brochures, leaflets, newspapers, journals and periodicals,

Taking into account that Part B of Annex I to UNMIK Regulation No. 1999/3, as amended, lists all goods with a zero rate of customs duty , and

For the purpose of amending Part B of Annex I to UNMIK Regulation No. 1999/3, as amended, to provide for the additional zero-rating of printed books, brochures, leaflets, newspapers, journals and periodicals,

Hereby promulgates the following:

Section 1  
Amendment

Part B of Annex I to UNMIK Regulation No. 1999/3, as amended, shall be replaced by the Annex to the present Regulation.

Section 2  
Entry into Force

The present Regulation shall enter into force on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of August, 2005.
