**IMPLEMENTING UNMIK REGULATION NO. 1999/3 ON THE
ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CUSTOMS AND OTHER RELATED
SERVICES IN KOSOVO**

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under section 6 of United Nations Interim Administration in Kosovo (UNMIK) Regulation No. 1999/3 of 31 August 1999, as amended, on the Establishment of the Customs and Other Related Services in Kosovo,

In conformity with the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation 2001/9 of 15 May 2005),

Having issued UNMIK Administrative Direction No. 2001/7 of 29 May 2001 Implementing UNMIK Regulation 1999/3 on the Establishment of the Customs and Other Related Services in Kosovo,

Duly noting the conclusion of the Interim Free Trade Agreement between UNMIK and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia on 31 August 2005,

For the purpose of repealing section 18 of UNMIK Administrative Direction No. 2001/7 as a consequence of conclusion of the Free Trade Agreement,

Hereby issues the following Administrative Direction:

Section 1
Repeal

Section 18 of UNMIK Administrative Direction No. 2001/7 is hereby repealed with effect from 31 August 2005.

Section 2
Entry into Force

The present Administrative Direction shall enter into force on 6 September 2005.
