REGULATION NO. 2006/20

**AMENDING UNMIK REGULATION 2001/36
ON THE KOSOVO CIVIL SERVICE**

The Special Representative of the Secretary General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under the United Nations Security Council resolution Number 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999,

Taking into account United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo (UNMIK) Regulation No. 1999/1 of 25 July 1999, as amended, on the Authority of the Interim Administration in Kosovo,

In conformity with the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9 of 15 May 2001),

Having promulgated UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/36 of 22 December 2001 on the Kosovo Civil Service,

Acting at the request of the Government,

For the purpose of amending sections 6 and 22 of UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/36 in order to facilitate the exercise by the Government of the responsibilities relating to the Kosovo Civil Service, and to enhance the meaningful engagement of the Office of the Prime Minister in the functioning of the Senior Public Appointments Committee,

Hereby promulgates the following:

Section 1
Amendments

As of the date on which the present Regulation enters into force, UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/36 shall be amended as follows:

- (a) Section 6 shall be revised to read:

Section 6
Code of Conduct

Civil Servants shall be bound by the Civil Service Code of Conduct attached as an annex to the present Regulation, or such other Civil Service Code of Conduct as may be subsequently approved by a Decision of the Government.

- (b) Section 22 shall be revised to read:

Section 22
Secretariat Services, Instructions and Guidelines

The Office of the Prime Minister shall provide the secretariat services to the SPAC and shall implement such measures as are necessary, including the issuance of instructions and guidelines, in respect of the functioning of SPAC and procedures for the appointment, dismissal and extension of contracts of SPAC appointees. Instructions issued pursuant to this section shall be subject to approval by the Government.

Section 2
Entry into Force

The present Regulation shall enter into force on 22 April 2006.
