**AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTIONAL FRAMEWORK FOR
PROVISIONAL SELF-GOVERNMENT IN KOSOVO**

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General (SRSG),

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Security Council resolution 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999,

Taking into account United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo (UNMIK) Regulation No. 1999/1 of 25 July 1999, as amended, on the Authority of the Interim Administration in Kosovo and the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9 of 15 May 2001),

Acting in conformity with section 14.3 of the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo,

For the purpose of amending the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9 of 15 May 2001),

Hereby promulgates the following:

Section 1
Amendments

As of the date on which the present Regulation enters into force, the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9) shall be amended as follows:

1.1 In Section 9.1.2, the words “on the basis of open lists” shall be inserted after the word “ballot.”

1.2 Section 9.1.3 (b) (ii) shall be revised to read: “Ten (10) seats shall be allocated to the other Communities as follows: the Roma Community one (1) seat; the Ashkali Community one (1) seat; the Egyptian Community one (1) seat; and one (1) seat shall be allocated either to the Roma, the Ashkali or the Egyptian Community based upon which Community received the highest number of valid votes; the Bosniak Community three (3) seats; the Turkish Community two (2) seats; and the Gorani Community one (1) seat.”

1.3 Section 9.1.3 (c) shall be revised to read:

“Each person having attained 18 years of age on the day of the relevant election who

- (i) is registered as a habitual resident of Kosovo, or
- (ii) is residing outside of Kosovo and has left Kosovo on or after 1 January 1998 and meets the criteria to be registered as a habitual resident in Kosovo, or
- (iii) has obtained the status of a refugee as defined in the Convention Relating to the Status of Refugees of 28 July 1951 and its Protocol of 16 December 1966 on or after 1 January 1998 and meets the criteria to be registered as a habitual resident of Kosovo,

shall have the right to vote in elections in Kosovo in accordance with the applicable law.”

1.4 Section 9.1.3 (d) shall be deleted and subsequent sections re-numbered accordingly.

1.5 In Section 9.1.4, the word “three” shall be replaced by “four.”

1.6 In Section 9.2.3, the word “three” shall be replaced by “four.”

Section 2 Entry into Force

The present Regulation shall enter into force on 4 October 2007.
